### STATE GOVERNMENT LEVY

Please note that a State Government Levy of \$3.50 for Dogs and \$2.00 for Cats is now included in the registration fee. The Levy is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership educational programs.

# Animal (Cat or Dog) Registration Fees

Reduced fees are available if your dog/cat meets the following requirements

## Dogs / Cats

- Desexed dogs/cats.
- Dogs kept for working stock.
- Dogs/cats kept for breeding by the proprietor of a domestic animal business conducted on registered premises.
- Dogs that have undergone approved obedience training which complies with Regulation 49 of the Domestic Animals Regulations 2005.
- Dogs/cats registered with an applicable organisation, if their owners are members of that organisation with which the dogs/cats are registered.
- Dogs/cats over 10 years old.

Prior to reduced fees being applicable, approved documentary evidence of sterilisation, obedience training or registration with approved associations is to be provided. Documentary evidence of sterilisation should be signed by a Veterinary Surgeon and include the date each animal was sterilised and a description of the animal.

**N.B. The full fee must be paid if the dog registered has been previously declared a menacing or dangerous dog.**

For the purpose of the Domestic Animals Act 1994 "owner" where the owner is a minor means a parent or guardian of that minor.

**Tags:** Life time tags have been issued by Council. Replacement tags are only issued if current tags are lost or damaged.

### Section 10 Domestic Animals Act 1994

*'The owner of a dog or cat must apply to register that dog or cat with the Council of the Municipal District in which the dog or cat is kept, if the animal is over three months old.'*

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** - Any puppy or kitten to be registered or any dog or cat being moved into the Shire of Campaspe municipality (as a new registration) must be microchipped before Council can accept registration.

The personal information on this form is required to include your dog/cat on the register administered by Council under the Domestic Animals Act 1994. You are required to provide this information under Section 10 of the Act and failure to provide the information may result in a penalty of \$793. The information is used by Council in connection with the administration and enforcement of the Act, and may be disclosed to other Councils or persons. ## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

If any dog listed on this renewal form is one of the following breeds you will be required to contact Council and arrange to complete a Restricted Breed Dog Declaration in relation to that animal:  
Pitbull Terrier or American Pitbull Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Dogo Argentino, Japanese Tosa, Perro de Presa Canario or, also known as Presa Canario. Completion of this declaration is required by law.

### Please Note:

Council Local Laws only permit a **maximum of 2 dogs and 2 cats** on any property that is zoned residential unless a permit to keep more has been granted by Council.

Animals in excess of this number should on no account be registered unless a permit has been obtained.

**Permit application** forms are included in Council's General Local Law No. 8 2015. They are to be completed and forwarded to Council.

**No** permit fees apply. Permits are available from any of the Customer Service Centres listed above.

- Dogs and cats over 10 years old are not subject to permit requirements but are required to be registered.
- Dogs engaged in the working of livestock are not subject to permit requirements but are required to be registered.

On receipt of a permit application, a decision will be made regarding the number of animals applied to be kept. The Applicant will then be advised of the number of animals finally approved under the permit. It is the Applicant's responsibility to comply with all registration requirements.
