Watering of **nature strip** trees will be the responsibility of landowners who, when making an application for a new or replacement nature strip tree commit to water the tree on a weekly basis, or as required for the establishment period of at least 12 months. This is particularly important to ensure that tree losses and replacement costs are minimised.
