2019 WickED Sustainability Awards Conditions

- Representatives of Campaspe Shire Council, Veolia and Biomix will select one winner and one special commendation award from the school entries
- The competition is open to all kindergarten, child care, primary and secondary school students in the Shire of Campaspe and Moama
- The entrant may submit an entry as an **individual student, class, group or entire school**, however any prizes will be awarded to the entire school
- Copyright of the entered item must belong to the entrant
- Entrants can only submit their own work
- Schools may submit more than one entry
- Stories must be submitted electronically in PDF, Word or PowerPoint format
- Photos must be supplied digitally and be the highest possible quality but sized at less than 10MB. If photos are included as part of a story, for display purposes photos must also be supplied as individual files
- Artwork must be no larger than 45cm x 30cm x 30cm
- If supplied digitally, posters must be the highest possible quality but sized at less than 10MB
- Posters submitted digitally should be in one of the following formats: JPEG (high quality), TIFF or PDF format. They must be large enough to be printed at high resolution (300dpi) at A4 size (297 x 210mm)
- Video length must not exceed 3 minutes
- Entries must be relevant to the competition theme: "avoid, reduce, reuse – keeping food waste out of landfill"
- No watermarks, signatures, or copyright notices may be added to photos, posters, artwork or videos
- All entries will be returned to entrants **only if requested by the entrant**
- It is the entrants' responsibility to ensure that all necessary permissions are obtained from any people who may feature in photos or videos
- Entries not accompanied by a signed entry form will not be included in the competition
- The closing date for entries is **Monday, 28 October 2019**
- The winners will be announced and prizes awarded at an awards ceremony held at the Campaspe Regional Library on **Tuesday, 12 November 2019 at 6:30pm**. Prize winners and finalists will be notified one week prior and expected to attend the ceremony
- The first prize winner will receive a cash prize for their school to the value of \$500, which the school is to put towards a sustainability project at the school
- The special commendation award recipient will receive a cash prize for their school to the value of \$200, which the school is to put towards a sustainability project at the school. Additional prizes may be awarded
- All entrants may have their entry published on Council publications (including Council's Facebook page) and in local media and names will be included
- Entrants' names may be published in order to give credit to their entry in the competition. The Campaspe Shire Council will not otherwise provide any personal details relating to any entrant to third parties
- Council reserves the right to use all entries to promote environmental sustainability in the WickED education program
- Entrants will be deemed to have understood the above rules and agree to be bound by them by completing this entry form and entering the competition
