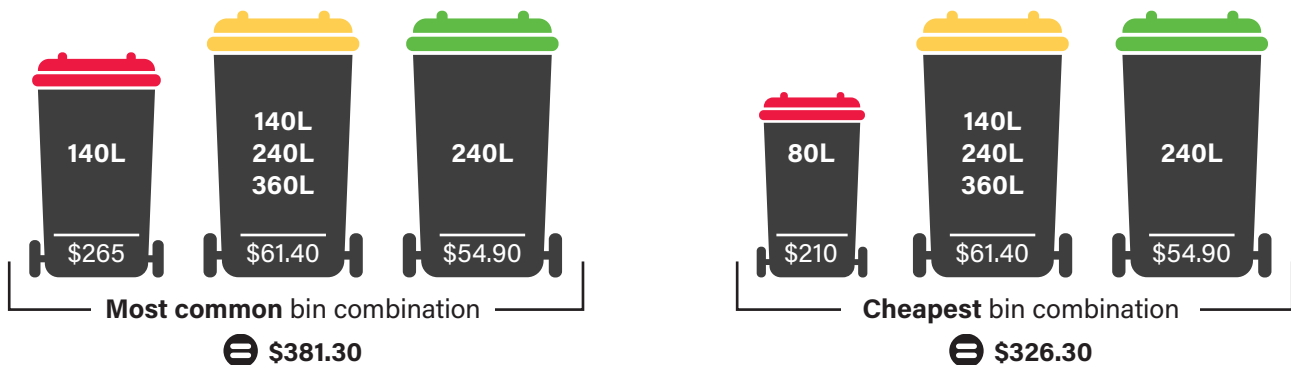


# Residential Kerbside Bins

## What bin sizes are best for my household?

2019/2020 prices



Residents in township areas opting for the small 80 litre waste (red) bin, a 360 litre recycling (yellow) bin and a 240 litre food & garden waste (green) bin will maximise recovery of resources and minimise waste to landfill.

## Should food & garden waste go in my red bin?

**No.** Here's why:

Food & garden waste in landfill creates methane, which is 25 times more damaging to our environment than carbon dioxide.

**The best option is to put your food scraps in your food & garden waste (green) bin.** Council sends it off to be turned into compost, which is cheaper, better for the environment and healthier for our entire community.

If you don't have a food & garden waste (green) bin, you can order one on council's website.

## What's being sent to landfill?

**All waste put in your red bin gets sent to landfill.**

Much of the material being put in Campaspe red bins can be recovered and recycled or composted.

On average, more than half (55 per cent) is food & garden waste and 16 per cent belongs in the recycling bin.

**Together we can make a difference to reduce waste and improve our environment.**
