Notice of intention to sell land

and call for Submissions

Pursuant to Section 189 of the Local Government Act 1989, Campaspe Shire Council intends to sell by private treaty the following land;

Crown Allotment 1V Section 23A, Township of Echuca, Parish of Echuca North comprised in Certificate of Title Volume 10084 Folio 722 known as the Loco Shed Land, 95 Sturt Street, Echuca, to Loco Shed Echuca Inc. for \$165 (GST inclusive). The proposed sale price is less than the current market value of this land because the buildings and infrastructure on this land are owned by the Echuca Loco Shed Inc. Should the Loco Shed Inc. become insolvent they will transfer the ownership of both land and building to a likeminded body, in accordance with their association rules, and this may also include transfer back to council ownership.

The proposed sale will be subject to contractual terms satisfactory to council.

Any submissions in relation to the proposed sale will be considered in accordance with Section 223 of the Local Government Act 1989, which provides that:-

Any submissions in respect of this matter received by council no later than 12 April 2019 shall be considered;

Any person who has made a submission to council is entitled to request in the submission that the person wishes to appear in person or to be represented by a person specified in the submission at a meeting of council or a committee to council to be heard in support of the submission.

Submitters should be aware that submissions are required to be available for public inspection. Following consideration of any submissions council may resolve either to proceed, or not to proceed, with the proposed sale.
