## Flu vaccinations

The flu vaccine will be available at immunisation sessions from May at a cost of \$30. Payments must be made in advance of attending the session, through a customer service centre or over the phone. The vaccine is free to persons over 65 years of age and children aged 6 months to 5 years, and individuals in the high risk category. Please bring your Medicare card with you when receiving the vaccine.

## Road Management Plan review

In accordance with Section 54 of the Road Management Act 2004 and the Road Management (General) Regulations 2016, Campaspe Shire Council gives notice it intends to conduct a review of its road management plan including council's register of public roads.

The purpose of the review, consistent with the role, functions and responsibilities of the council as a road authority under the Act, is to ensure that the standards in relation to, and the priorities being given to, the inspection, maintenance and repair of the roads and the classes of road to which the council's road management plan applies are safe, efficient and appropriate for use by the community served by the council.

The review will apply to all of the roads and classes of roads to which the road management plan applies.

A copy of council's current road management plan can be reviewed on council's website at [www.campaspe.vic.gov.au](http://www.campaspe.vic.gov.au) or may be inspected between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday at any of council's service centres.

Any person that wishes to make a submission may do so in writing addressed to 'Review of the Road Management Plan', Infrastructure Development Coordinator, Campaspe Shire Council, PO Box 35, Echuca or by email to [shire@campaspe.vic.gov.au](mailto:shire@campaspe.vic.gov.au) no later than 4pm on 3 June 2019. A person who has made a submission and requested that they be heard in support of their submission is entitled to appear in person or be represented by a person acting on their behalf before a meeting of the council, the day, time and place of which will be advised.
