Works notice

Changing Places toilet facility, Echuca

Construction of a changing places toilet facility will shortly begin in the Echuca High Street car park. Works will take approximately three to four months to complete. Car park users will experience minor disruption in accessing the existing public toilets at the site.

Headworks Road, Torrumbarry

Road safety improvement works will take place on Headworks Road, between 11 February and 15 February. Motorists will experience some traffic delays with traffic restrictions in place.

Lake Road, Kyabram

Road construction works have started on a section of Lake Road, between Fenaughty and Pettifer Streets. Works include replacement of concrete gutters (kerb and channel), the road surface and water main. Works will take approximately 14 weeks. During construction there will be some traffic disruption and local access to properties will be maintained. Local residents will be provided with two weeks notice before construction starts.
