From 1 July, food scraps can be added to the green bin. Before this happens, residents in townships across the shire are being asked to select their free food scrap caddy online via our website before 31 May, to help move food waste from the kitchen to the kerbside green bin. Caddies will then be delivered in June, ready for food scraps to be added from 1 July.
