**Sites:** I = irrigated land. W = wet, waterlogged or depressions areas or areas that are wet because of excess irrigation water in summer, or hold water during the rest of the year. S = saline discharge areas, areas that are salt affected can often be identified by the loss of white clover and dominance of salt tolerant plants (such as Barley grass). C = check bank plantings or irrigated shelter belts (areas where irrigated perennial pasture is growing well). D = Dryland, plants with some drought tolerance, suited to the dry periods across the plains.
