**KANYAPELLA BASIN (KOYUGA)**

15min from Echuca  
2305 Tehan Road, Kanyapella

Kanyapella Basin is the remains of a former lake, Lake Kanyapella, which resulted of earth movements (Cadell Fault) about 18,000 years ago. The site plays an important role in the Yorta Yorta's cultural and spiritual connection. When the lake drained, winds blew sand from the dry lake bed to form sand dunes. The remainder of the area is River Red Gum and Black Box dominated shallow freshwater marsh and freshwater meadow, home to many native bird species and is a known eagle nesting site.

**KOW SWAMP**

Kow Swamp, also known as Ghow Swamp, is a permanent wetland with spectacular views, making it very popular for photographers. Steeped in significant history, Kow Swamp is the site of the discovery of evidence of early humans. It has been established in the 1960s that tribes lived in this area 10,000 to 20,000 years ago.

**KYABRAM ERN MILES RESERVE & TROTTER TRACK RESERVE**

30min from Echuca  
South Boundary Road & Saunders Street, Kyabram

These reserves within the town boundary offer extensive native bushlands, walking tracks and bird watching opportunities.

Both locations are valuable habitats for 40 birds species including birds of prey - falcons and eagles - along with smaller birds and wrens, and native wildlife.

**MT HOPE**

Mount Hope Nature Conservation Reserve comprises of seven small granite boulders - perfect for rock climbing and abseiling. From the picnic area at the northern side it is only a short, gentle climb to the top, rewarded by remarkable views over Kow Swamp and the surrounding pastoral district.

Travel west towards Mitiamo and take in all that Terrick Terrick National Park has to offer.

The park contains one of the largest, most intact indigenous northern plains vegetation in Victoria. These lands are home to many rare and endangered animals including more than 100 bird species. Perfect for a scenic drive, bush walk or picnic - enjoy stunning views from the summit or fully immerse yourself by staying overnight.

**GUNBOWER ISLAND**

Gunbower Island is the 'Kakadu of the South' - the largest inland island and a haven for wildlife. Stretching from Koondrook to Torrumbarry Weir, the 20,000 hectare island includes 130km of river frontage filled with expanses of River Red Gum and Boxwood forests supporting protected populations of native mammals, reptiles and 160 unique bird species. An idyllic location for camping, canoeing, a spot of bushwalking or bird-watching.

View Rochy's awe-inspiring contribution to the GrainCorp silo art trail featuring local wildlife - the Squirrel Glider and Azure Kingfisher. Eight impressive themed murals frame the entrance to town on the Northern Highway and are recreated each year for the town's annual Mural Festival.

The Iddles Lane Mural is a tribute to the renowned Victoria Police Detective and tells the story of his family and career, found in the main street.

Rushworth was established during the Victorian Gold Rush in 1853. Much of its original character is retained and reflected in the National Trust classified historic building streetscape.

Situated 7kms from Rushworth, Whroo village grew around the base of Balaclava Hill in 1853 after the discovery of over 20,000 ounces of gold. Now truly a ghost town, find delight in Whroo's natural ambience, trails and history and enjoy lunch in the picnic area.

Balacava Gold Mine is one of Victoria's largest open cut mines, now closed to public access but viewable from platforms around the site.





Northern Victoria Regional Driving Map



## Our towns



**TONGALA**  
A beautiful town steeped in history. Visit Tongala to view its award-winning street art comprising more than 30 murals telling the stories that shape the town's history and brings to life the picturesque streets lined with trees and boutique shops. Tongala honours its servicemen and women with the Third Calvary and Lighthouse memorials and the Vietnam Avenue of Honour.



**KYABRAM**  
Kyabram has a vibrant shopping strip and a strong café culture. 'Ky', as it's known to locals, is home to Zoos Victoria Kyabram Fauna Park, showcasing a large range of Australian native animals, as well as an adorable clan of Meerkats and the world's most venomous species of snake, the Inland Taipan. The Water Tank murals painted by Jimmy D'Vate feature many local native flora and fauna. The Town Hall offers a range of art collections and the Isobel Harvie fashion collection.



**GIRGARRE**  
Gargarro Botanic Garden is a jewel in the crown of the Campaspe shire. The gardens, including the Gargarro Soundshell, has led to the burgeoning creation of a bold, beautiful and best practice garden, celebrating indigenous history in a parkland that stimulates the senses. The Gargarro Café and a nursery is on site and the town's Sound Walk is close by. Girgarre is a tight-knit community of friendly locals that offers free camping facilities and amenities and a not-to-be-missed monthly farmers market.



**STANHOPE**  
Stanhope became the first 'Legendary' capital of Australia in 2015, a nod to the Fonterra milk processing factory which features a large mural of photos of the history of the town and its dairy background. The town also boasts the Montevideo Maru mural, Station Park Arts Space, a gallery, a country music club, a pub and other places to eat, drink and shop. Check out the rail trail or the photo display on the side of the Business Centre. Hometown to Australia's 18th Prime Minister, Sir John McEwan.



**RUSHWORTH**  
Surrounded by the significant Ironbark Forest and historic goldfields, Rushworth retains much of the charm and character of the 1853 Gold Rush era - reflected in its National Trust classified streetscape; one of the most impressive in rural Victoria. Explore the Rushworth to Murchison Rail Trail, or the many other scenic bushwalks and historical markers. It is a short drive to Waranga Basin.



**ROCHESTER**  
Located on the banks of the Campaspe River, Rochester is home to cycling legend Sir Hubert Opperman and the renowned Rocky Sports Museum. The museum showcases a vast collection of sporting memorabilia and private tours are available. Impressive Silo Art, Iddles lane and a myriad of murals provide plenty of interest for visitors. Country-style pubs and cafes offer great food and friendly hospitality.



**COLBINABBIN**  
Colbo is a great destination for a Sunday drive. You can't miss the amazing Tim Bowtell painted silos celebrating the town's history. Tim's work also adorns the side wall of the newly renovated pub. The pub is so popular, you need to book ahead. The Colbinabbin General Store offers coffee and food as well as a range of local honey, preserves, textiles, crafts and cards. The wineries are a stones throw from here with quality wines. Some offer food, music and accommodation.



**LOCKINGTON**  
A vibrant farming community famous for its town channel network that features the giant 'Locky Ness Monster'. The Living Heritage Complex has an amazing collection of farm equipment and pays homage to the late Kevin Sarre, the well-known shearing champion. The park and pump track are a great way to while-away a few hours with the kids. The community-owned pub boasts very good food.



**TORRUMBARRY**  
Torrumbarry is home to one of the largest weirs in Australia. This heritage-listed weir and lock chamber maintains the height of the Murray River, creating optimal conditions. It is the starting point for the annual Southern 80 ski race and a popular spot for fishing and recreational water activities.

**GUNBOWER**  
Gunbower is best known as the gateway to the largest inland island in Australia - Kow Swamp. Surrounding Gunbower Island is a series of meandering creeks and waterways, offering a retreat for nature lovers, fishing and kayaking. Gunbower also is steeped in significant history, with local aboriginal tribes living in harmony off the rich lands for thousands of years.
