What we have heard

From our contact with the Colbinabbin / Toolleen / Corop communities, face to face and by survey, we understand that the local priorities are:

Community health



- Friendly, rich and vibrant communities
- Retaining the swimming pool
- Hall playground improvements, such as safe fencing as it is on a busy road
- More dedicated walkways and signage around paths and roads.

Environment



- A healthy natural environment
- Water issues including maintaining water in Greens Lake
- Increased greening of main street
- Education around recycling.

Infrastructure



- Recreational facilities, particularly sporting facilities
- Road maintenance and repair, including unsealed roads
- Tree management near intersections
- Improved water infrastructure would bring opportunities.

Education and workforce



- Attracting skilled professional workers to the area
- Education courses at the hall
- Farming may have changed but still need itinerant workforce.

Housing



- Protecting farm land
- Lack of housing is a problem – no opportunity for expansion or development – review planning scheme.

Communication



- Meet the changing needs of the community
- Be more transparent by explaining decisions made by council and communicate with community more
- Increased engagement with Council.

Future focus

- Advocate for Stock and Domestic pipeline extension to the south
