## What we have heard

From our contact with the Kyabram community, face to face and by survey, we understand that the local priorities are:

### Groups

- Access to good food and exercise options
- Increase in services required: youth, community transport (more people to have access), community health in general including mental health
- Mothers groups required
- Social and sporting groups declining.



### Town of trees!

- A healthy natural environment
- Greening Kyabram – town of trees
- Improved management of roadsides and rubbish.



### Lifestyle

- More bicycle paths and options for active travel
- Improve existing local facilities
- Growing interest in tourism in Kyabram



### Local education

- Local job opportunities, especially for young people
- Local training providers recognised, need to focus on broadening scope of services to meet the needs of the community
- Innovative farming supported
- Improve public transport and internet connectivity
- Numerous requests for improved education services and topics.



### Aboriginal Culture increase

- Sustainable population growths
- Increase Aboriginal presence and recognition
- Questions around the future opportunities of the old school site
- Concerns about keeping up with developments.
