Healthy communities

- · Sense of safety and security
- Food security and aged care residents locally
- Mental health issues.

Environment

- Access to water
- Local wildlife management

Infrastructure

- High quality community assets, such as roads, libraries, parks
- Update roads and increase safety around main shopping area with speed humps
- Maintain and update facilities locally – recreation reserve, netball facilities, halls.

Short courses

- Local job opportunities, especially for young people
- More short courses run in general, using shire halls where applicable.
 Licences, short certificates that only take a few hours, elderly IT sessions, etc.

Support

- Increased transparency on Council decision making
- Support required from Council to assist people with groups, potential grants, advocacy, service requests, and assisting the residents with understanding why council decisions have been made.
