What we have heard

From our contact with the Nanneella community, face to face and by survey, we understand that the local priorities are:

Healthy communities



- Sense of safety and security
- Food security and aged care residents locally
- Mental health issues.

Environment



- Access to water
- Local wildlife management – waste management, fauna such as endangered species but also feral animals, flora such as native grasslands but also weed management.

Infrastructure



- High quality community assets, such as roads, libraries, parks
- Update roads and increase safety around main shopping area with speed humps
- Maintain and update facilities locally – recreation reserve, netball facilities, halls.

Short courses



- Local job opportunities, especially for young people
- More short courses run in general, using shire halls where applicable. Licences, short certificates that only take a few hours, elderly IT sessions, etc.

Farming/ zoning balance



- Protecting farmland
- Land shortage for development – review town boundaries
- Massive impacts on farming due to lack of water.

Support



- Increased transparency on Council decision making
- Support required from Council to assist people with groups, potential grants, advocacy, service requests, and assisting the residents with understanding why council decisions have been made.

Future focus

- Investigate and promote alternative and different agricultural activities to enable sustainability
