
Q5 How many people, including children, live in your household?

Q6 Do you have a recycling bin that is collected fortnightly?








Q8 What do you think happens to your recycling?





Q10 Do you use a transfer station ('tip') to dispose of your unwanted materials?





Q11 How much effort do you spend sorting your unwanted materials before you go to a transfer station ('tip')?





Q12 Why is it important to sort unwanted materials before going to a transfer station ('tip')? (select all that apply)





Q13 Which of these items are recycled free of charge at all Campaspe transfer stations ('tips')? (select all items you think are free)







Q15 Do you have a green bin for food and garden waste that is collected fortnightly?







Q19 Which of the following items can you place in Campaspe's green bins and/or in a backyard compost bin/ pile?








Q24 How often do you throw away food you could have eaten?
