### Overview

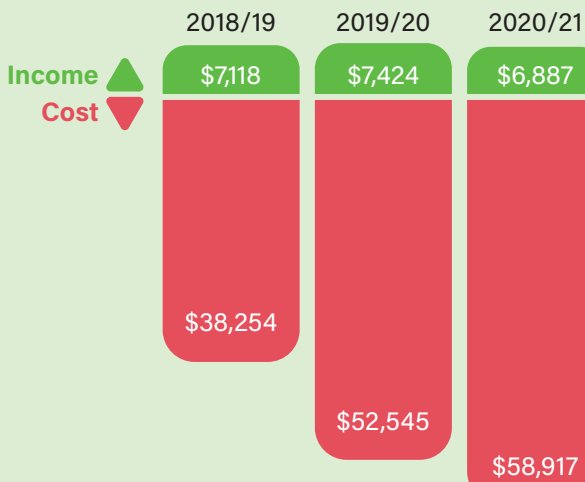
The 2018 Aquatic Facilities Review identified the Colbinabbin swimming pool and its facilities require complete renovation to meet minimum industry standards.

- Pool and buildings require extensive overhaul
- The area fails to meet disability access requirements
- The pool infrastructure (eg. pumps, filters, fencing, seating) require extensive overhaul.

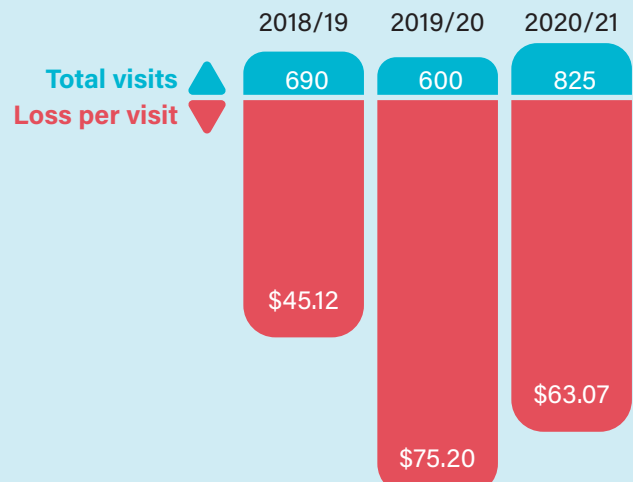

- › The Colbinabbin Primary School currently delivers its own Learn to Swim program using their own providers
- › No classes or programs are offered at the pool
- › The pool was built in 1979
- › The majority of users come from within a radius of 15km
- › Open from November to March each year
- › All seven outdoor pools are (on average) 50+ years old
