Overview

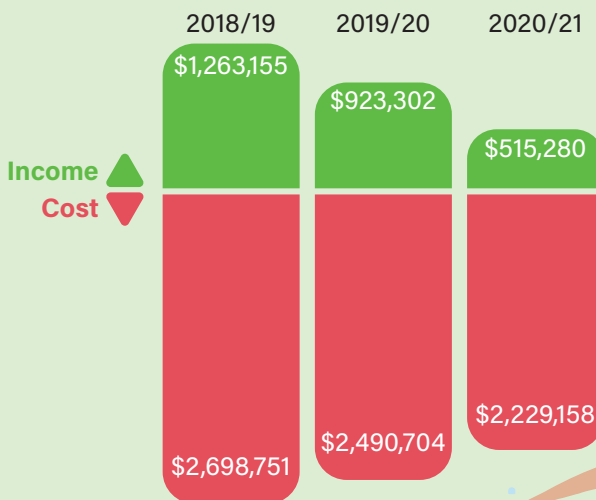
The 2018 Aquatic Facilities Review identified the EWMAC swimming pool and its facilities mostly meet minimum industry standards.

- The pool, amenities, gymnasium, group fitness and reception areas are DDA compliant
- The multipurpose room fails to meet disability access requirements
- Some of the facility infrastructure requires an overhaul.

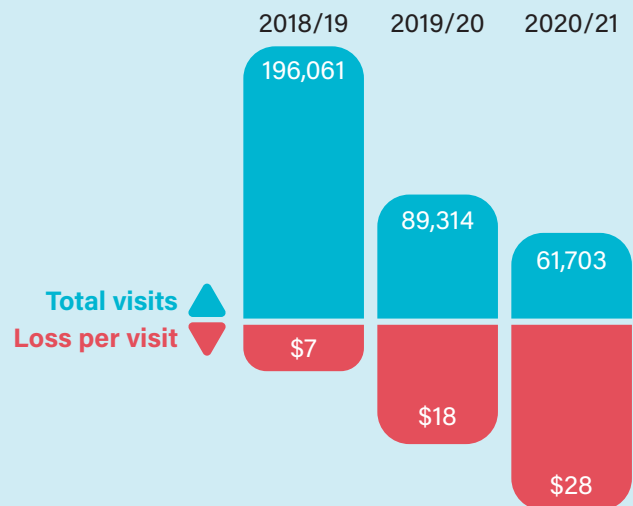

Fast Facts

- › The pool was built in 1954 and was renovated in 1996
- › This is the only indoor Council run pool
- › 150 Learn to Swim classes per week
- › 9 aquatic group fitness classes per week
- › 12 swimming carnivals per year
- › 20 school bookings per year
- › 130 exclusive use private hires per year
- › 10 hours use per week by the Echuca Swim Club
- › 4 hours hire per week by an independent swim instructor
- › 4 hours hire per week by Allied health (aqua and dry activities)
- › Gymnasium is accessible
