

Australia Day Awards 2024 Nomination Criteria

The Campaspe Shire Council Australia Day Awards celebrate the achievements and contributions of individuals and community organisations or groups in our region. These prestigious awards are one of the highest honours a Council can bestow to publicly acknowledge local heroes, whose dedication and contributions may otherwise go unnoticed.

This information is to aid in the completion of the **Campaspe Shire Council 2024 Nomination form**.

Award Categories

- Citizen of the Year
- Young Citizen of the Year
- Community Group of the Year

Citizen of the Year

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Citizen of the Year Award, nominees must:

- Be an Australian Citizen;
- Be a resident of the Campaspe Shire Council area (when nominations close);
- Be 25 years of age or older on 1 January of the year the award is given;
- Not have received the same award previously;
- Not be a current sitting Councillor, nor have been in the past two years;
- Not be nominated by an Officer of the Council or Councillor;
- Not to be nominated by a member of the selection panel; and
- All applications must have a supporting referee.

Selection Criteria

When considering nominations for this award, the selection panel shall have regard to the following criteria:

- Has made an outstanding contribution to the community;
- Has been an inspiration / role model to the community;
- Has shown achievements in community activities, academic, sporting, personal, cultural, environmental and/ or social responsibility; and
- Has demonstrated a commitment to enhancing the welfare and wellbeing of the community, which has benefits to others.

Young Citizen of the Year

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Young Citizen of the Year Award, nominees must:

- Be an Australian Citizen;
- Be a resident of the Campaspe Shire Council area (when nominations close);
- Be 25 years of age or younger on 1 January of the year the award is given;
- Not have received the same award previously;
- Not be a current sitting Councillor, nor have been in the past two years;
- Not be nominated by an Officer of the Council or Councillor;
- Not to be nominated by a member of the selection panel; and
- All applications must have a supporting referee.

Selection Criteria

When considering nominations for this award, the selection panel shall have regard to the following criteria:

- Has made an outstanding contribution to the community;
- Has been an inspiration / role model to the community;
- Has shown achievements in community activities, academic, sporting, personal, cultural, environmental and/ or social responsibility; and
- Has demonstrated a commitment to enhancing the welfare and wellbeing of the community, which has benefits to others.

Community Group of the Year

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Community Group of the Year, the event must:

- Be a not-for-profit organisation that provides opportunities for the community to participate and contribute to social, economic and cultural life.
- Bring recognition and credit to the community through a cultural, environmental or sporting achievement within the Campaspe Shire Council
- Not be nominated by an Officer of the Council or Councillor;
- Not have received the award previously; and
- Have a supporting referee

Selection Criteria

When considering nominations for this award, the selection panel shall have regard to the following criteria in no particular order:

- The groups service and benefit to the community
- The groups significant involvement of volunteers and empowerment of the community; and
- The groups reflection on the community values and contribution to the diversity of the community.

How to complete your nomination

Nominations must be submitted on the official Campaspe Shire Council Australia Day Awards 2024 Nomination Form (Nomination Form pages 1 - 3)

The answer to the question, "Why are you nominating this person / group?" requires a minimum of 100 words and maximum of 500 words. Include as much detail as you can as this forms the majority of the material to be assessed by the judging panel.

Additional details can be included in a separate document (maximum 3 pages) along with details / copies of any other awards or supporting documents (i.e. photos, newspaper or magazine articles about the Nominee and their achievements).

Please provide all required information on the nomination form.

Failure to provide complete information may result in the nomination not being considered.

Selection Process

Following the close of nominations, the area Australia Day Awards Selection Panel will score nominations based on the Selection Criteria.

Winners of the local area awards will then be judged to select an overall Shire Award winner in each category.

In the result of a tied vote for the overall Shire Award winners, the Mayor will have the final decision.

The decision of the Australia Day Awards Selection Panel is final, and no additional correspondence will be entered in to.

Award Ceremony

Award recipients are announced on Australia Day at Australia Day Events across the shire.

All nominees and nominators will be invited to attend the award announcements on 26 January 2024.
