Victoria Park

What is it?

Reconfiguration and upgrade of the community and recreation infrastructure to align with the construction of the new Echuca Moama bridge.

Why it's important

Victoria Park is a key regional recreation space. The construction of the second Echuca Moama bridge necessitates the redesign of the space to suit sporting and recreation users. The master plan will:

- Replace the existing ageing user infrastructure with a multi-use pavilion
- Upgrade internal informal paths to improve safety and strengthen pedestrian linkages along the Murray River
- Improve picnic and viewing facilities and amenities
- Improve the protection of important historic elements
- Improve boat launching and trailer parking facilities
- Upgrade playing surfaces and car parking
- Provide for events including Southern 80 Ski Race, sporting carnivals and concerts

The redesign will provide pedestrian and cycling links from Echuca West to Moama. The trails proposed in the Victoria Park Master Plan will extend these opportunities into the natural bush reserve.

What we're seeking

- Total estimate funding – \$8m
- Australian Government - \$2m
- Victorian Government \$3m
- Local Government and community – \$3m - Committed

Council is asking for co-commitment of \$2m in federal funding to inject new life into this vital regional public space.
