

Victoria Park Multipurpose Building & Changerooms

Major Project Update - 04/02/2025

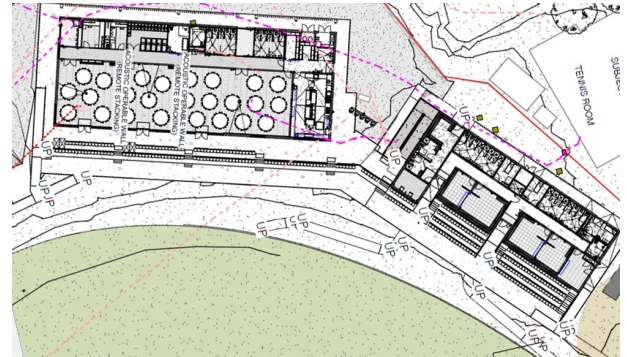
Funded in the main by the Growing Regions Program, (\$11.3m) and supported with another \$2m by Campaspe Shire Council (Total \$13.3m) this major project is anticipated to commence construction in the forth quarter of 2025.

The project will see the demolition of the existing and outdated pavilion, public toilets, social shed and grandstand / changerooms and the provision of a raised pavilion and changerooms arcing around the northwest corner of the oval.

With an indicative overall footprint of approximately 1,700m², and approx. 1,000m² of fully enclosed internal space, this marquee project is of prime importance to the stakeholders and community.

Project design documentation is currently being reviewed and amendments being made as required. Revised civil and structural design are under development to minimise risk with the documentation to be completed in February-March which will enable procurement in the third quarter of 2025. A two stage procurement process for construction commenced with an EOI in November 2024, and closed in December 2024, the respondents are currently being assessed. Up to five of the best respondents will be invited via targeted Request for Tender to submit a second application and be awarded the construction contract.

The grant agreement was received in January and will be executed within the first 2 weeks of February 2025 allowing the long awaited project to proceed.
