

## 2022 Flood Recovery Clean-Up Program Local Trades Factsheet

## **Working with Johns Lyng Group**

We're working with lead contractor Johns Lyng Group (JLG) to deliver the 2022 Flood Recovery Clean-up Program. JLG has extensive experience in responding to emergency events and puts community at the centre of recovery efforts, engaging local trades in recovery and repair efforts.

## 2022 Flood Clean-Up Program

The Victorian and Australian Governments have dedicated \$150 million for a state-coordinated flood clean-up program.

The program includes:

- free all-hazard structural assessments for affected residential properties and small businesses (commercial light)
- supporting local councils to collect flood debris and waste from kerbsides (nature strips).

Emergency Recovery Victoria (ERV) is the State's lead agency for relief and recovery and is responsible for coordination of the program.

Johns Lyng Group is the lead contractor for the clean-up program in partnership with local councils. They were selected from the State Clean-up Panel which includes a requirement for the contractor to take a local-first approach. For this program the workforce will be made up of more than 70% local trades.

Local councils in conjunction with JLG and ERV are collecting flood debris and waste from kerbsides and disposing of waste into licensed tipping sites as part of the Street Debris Removal program. Local councils must register for the program. They nominate the area of proposed works and ERV and JLG assess and remove all waste debris deposited on the kerbside, or the LGA nominated location. ERV and JLG then sort and process the waste.

JLG is also supporting the delivery of all-hazards structural assessments. Home owners, small business and not-for-profit property owners can register for a free all-hazard structural assessment of their structure damaged by the 2022 Victorian Flood event. Once the property owner has registered, ERV contacts them to process the registration and book the inspection.

JLG conducts the inspection and a report is provided to the property owner and to the local council. Where make-safe works are required and the structure is not insured this can also be coordinated through JLG, who will continue to work with local trades.

JLG plays a coordination approach supporting local trades and sub-contractors to complete work within the affected area, you can register to be involved via the QR code below.

ERV is committed to supporting local communities to respond locally and encourages local trades to register with for the 2022 Flood Recovery Clean-Up Program with JLG. ERV is also establishing trade hubs within affect regions to ensure local trades can continue to operate and support local economies.
