# Free Green Waste Disposal

To assist in cleaning up properties prior to the fire season, residents will be able to dispose of green waste free of charge at any of Council's eight transfer stations for four weeks, the exemption period running from Saturday, 10 December to Sunday, 8 January. Residents are asked to separate their green waste load from all other general waste. Any contaminated green waste loads will not be accepted free of charge.

All transfer stations are closed on Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day. For centre locations and opening hours, go to Council's website.

#### Kerbside Flood Waste

Kerbside household flood waste collections have been running in Rochester for around six weeks. State Government contractors will stop running these collections in Rochester as of 5pm on Sunday, 11 December. We encourage Rochester residents to get all remaining household flood waste onto their nature strips ASAP and to register their property address well before 11 December. The Rochester Transfer Station will continue to take flood waste free of charge until the end of the year. # **Echuca Recovery Centre**
