Project Update - March 2025

Waranga Rail Trail - Opening Tuesday 1 April 2025

Council is pleased to announce that construction of the Waranga Rail Trail is almost complete, and will open to the public on Tuesday 1 April 2025.

Completion of these works will provide the community with a 19 kilometre rail trail following the alignment of the decommissioned railway line from Rushworth to Murchison. It features two surface types: a 2.5m-wide 1km-long asphalt path which begins at the High Street footpath in Rushworth and concludes at Bendigo-Murchison Road; and a 10km gravel section that continues east to the shire boundary.



The official opening ceremony is scheduled for Saturday 17 May 2025 at 10am, to coincide with the monthly Rushworth market.

Council is also developing information signs to be placed at High Street in Rushworth, interpretive signage at key locations, and distance markers along the length of the trail.
