Immunisations are available free of charge for the following ages:

- 2 months (available from 6 weeks old)
- 4 months
- 6 months
- 12 months (must be 1 year old, or older)
- 18 months
- 4 years

- If your child has had vaccines overseas, or is behind in their vaccinations, please speak to the Immunisation team prior to attending a session.
- Please bring your child's health and development book and your Medicare card to the session.

Paid immunisations

Some immunisations are not free and require payment.

Payments can be made at the appointment by EFTPOS only. No cash is accepted.

Immunisation(s)	Recommended for
Flu Vaccine	No cost to people over 65 years, under 5 years and at risk groups. All other clients at a cost
Varicella (Chickenpox)	Recommended for non-immune adults
Hepatitis A Hepatitis A & B Hepatitis B	Recommended for people working in child care, preschools, disability services, health care, and sewerage workers
Boostrix - Diphtheria, Tetanus And Pertussis (Whooping Cough)	Recommended for adults having contact with young children
Measles, Mumps, Rubella	Recommended for non-immune adults
IPV Polio	Recommended for non-immune adults
Adult Meningococcal	Recommended for non-immune adults
