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Common name: The name the plant is commonly referred to. There may be multiple common names per plant. **Species name:** The botanical name used to describe a plant. There is only accepted botanical name per plant. **Height:** Tree heights will vary per site; heights are given as an indication of the species potential.

Soils: Indicates the soil type/s each plant is best suited to: **s** = sand, **sl** = sandy loam, **l** = loam, **cl** = clay loam, **c** = clay

Sites: I = irrigated land. W = wet, waterlogged or depressions areas or areas that are wet because of excess irrigation water in summer, or hold water during the rest of the year. S = saline discharge areas, areas that are salt affected can often be identified by the loss of white clover and dominance of salt tolerant plants (such as Barley grass). C = check bank plantings or irrigated shelter belts (areas where irrigated perennial pasture is growing well). D = Dryland, plants with some drought tolerance, suited to the dry periods across the plains.

Orders must be in multiples of 10 per species
